

2018 Fact Sheet July 12, 2018 Harris Chain of Lakes – Leesburg, FL

Competition dates: December 5-8, 2018

Official practice: December 2-4, 2018

BTC waters off limits: Beginning 12:01 AM Central Time, November 19, 2018

through December 1, 2018.

BTC Tournament waters:

The tournament waters will be Harris Chain of Lakes and all rivers, canals and creeks connecting to the Harris Chain of Lakes. Lakes permitted to fish include: Griffin, Eustis, Harris, Little Harris, Denham, Dora, Beauclaire, Carlton, Trout and Horseshoe. North boundary: Moss Bluff Lock and Dam on the Oklawaha River. South boundary: Lake Apopka. West boundary: Lake Denham. East boundary: Lake Carlton. Only water open to ALL public fishing will be considered tournament waters. Any waters closed to public fishing will be closed to this tournament's contestants.

IMPORTANT

Beginning at 12:01 AM central, Monday, November 19th, continuing through the final weigh-in of the 2018 BTC, Saturday, December 8, 2018, other than using publicly-available information (e.g. newspaper and Internet reports) 2018 BTC contestants cannot SOLICIT or gather any information via phone, electronic devices or any other means, about locating or catching fish on BTC waters unless that information comes from another 2018 BTC contestant. NO EXCEPTIONS.

License: ALL must have a Florida license.

BTC rules: 2018 Official Bassmaster Team Championship rules apply.

Creel: Total limit per boat is 5 legal bass, 12" in Length
